We are planning on lots of sun, fun and fellowship!! TIGHT BUDGETS

I believe that the summer months are here. The weather has been a little confused, but it is just about June so it must be summer. With summer vacations starting and the gas prices up so high it becomes more difficult to meet the extra costs of living and still full fill the financial promises that we have made to ministries. WFST has already noticed a drop in the monthly gifts to the ministry. In April we received contributions of \$8,905.03 and in May we received \$7072.58. Our monthly budget is \$11,230.36. We have fallen short by \$6,483.11 over the last 2 months. We are trying to cut cost as best as we can. We will save some payroll costs over the next two months as some part-time employees have asked for some time off. But our larger expenses are harder to cut back on. Insurance and Electrical costs are some of our highest monthly expenses. Combined they were \$4165.27 or 46.77% of our budget. WFST has a little cash in savings to help offset a shortfall in gifts from time to time, however we do not have enough to survive a couple more months of large short falls. Please remember us when you make plans for your giving. If you can make a gift to us it would come at a time when things are running short. Please keep WFST in your prayers. I have shared the need, and I have been a good steward of the funds that have been sent in. I do believe that our God will hear our prayers and will lead His family to supply our need. Thank you
